What is a Title One School?

A Title One school is a public school where 38% or more of the students qualify for free or reduced lunch prices. The Federal government awards Title One schools with funding above and beyond what is allotted by the local governing bodies.

Additional Faculty and Staff

Lowering Class sizes:

- 5th grade- 18.7
- 6th grade- 17.2

These averages are significantly lower than class sizes in similar grades across the state and district.

We have 4 teachers paid through Title 1 funds.



Intervention

We've added two additional Reading and Math Interventionist that work with identified students needing assistance.
