I will take the ACCUPLACER college placement exam.

This test is on the computer and is NOT timed. The average testing time is 2 hours.

About ACCUPLACER

Reading Test will assess information and ideas, rhetoric, synthesis, and vocabulary.

Writing Test will assess the ability to revise and edit multi-paragraph text. Expression of ideas (development, organization, and effective language use) and Standard English Conventions (sentence structure, usage, and punctuation) will all be included.

Math/Arithmetic Test will assess computation, order of operations, estimation and rounding, comparing and ordering values in different formats and recognizing equivalent values across formats. Whole number operations, fraction operations, decimal operations, percentages, and number comparisons and equivalents will be included.

Math/Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics (QAS) Test will assess rational numbers, ration/proportional relationships, exponents, algebraic expressions, linear equations, linear applications and graphs, probability sets, descriptive statistics, and geometry concepts.

Math/Advanced Algebra and Functions (AAF) Test will assess linear functions, linear applications and graphs, factoring, quadratics, functions, radical and rational equations, polynomial equations, exponential and logarithmic equations, and trigonometry.

Essay (WritePlacer) portion allows students to enter an essay into an onscreen text box and submit for a score.

Students can take ACCUPLACER in-person on the campus of Spartanburg Community College or Greenville Technical College.

The closest option is the Tyger River Campus, Tyger River Building of SCC located on Hwy 290, Duncan, SC. Testing is available for students M-Th 8:00am-3:00pm, Friday 8:00-11:00am. Please call 864-892-6121 for a testing appointment.

At this time, students can take ACCUPLACER remotely, through SCC, due to COVID-19. Students must use a computer with a working webcam, reliable Wi-Fi, and appropriate testing environment.
